How to Become a Poet during Your English Drama Class

This workshop teaches you how to use simple and powerful techniques to unfold your students' creative potential during your English Drama Classes. We will do the "5 Words in Shade and Light" exercise and use the acronym technique to unlock one's Inner Poet.

Warm-up **MMM** – chest resonator, head resonator Improvisation with the sound Name (adjective + sound + movement) (repeat) 'It's Ok' intonation Yawning – chest resonator Pass your name (adjective + sound + movement) (repeat) Walking – EYE contact; HELLO! Pass the sound (at school, from an animal...) **Greetings:** each meeting with a new person should be different: like Ladies Emotional scale 20-40-60-80-100%: Fear Joy **Similarities** Copy someone's movements **Concentration games:** Escape from someone Names with the balls Follow zip-zap-pau; Sword game (cut heads, cut legs, cut apart) **Your Name written with Your nose** (stress release at the back of the head) Associations with the rhythm **Dark And Light Stories** 5 words in the shade 5 words in the light I am ... I am ... You are ... 1. One Sentence, using 3+ words from the Dark and Light sections: 2. 6 words poem
